3. Every member of the Rotary Club replaces **5** incandescent light bulbs with **5** CFL's or LED's.
4. Every member of the Rotary Club recycles **5** categories of throwaway items, such as aluminum cans, paper, plastic, glass, batteries or ink cartridges.
5. Every member of the Rotary Club plugs at least **5** electronic devices, such as TVs and computers, into power strips and shuts off strips when not in use.
